CORE has been awarded a £10,000 grant from the Coalfields Regeneration Trust so that the Job Club can continue for a further period.

Over the last 6 months, through Futures Funding, we have achieved a 64% success rate in helping our clients either into work or training. We celebrated this outstanding result in November with an event for all those who were or had ever been enrolled in the Job Club. Participants enjoyed refreshments and received a certificate of completion and achievement.
